

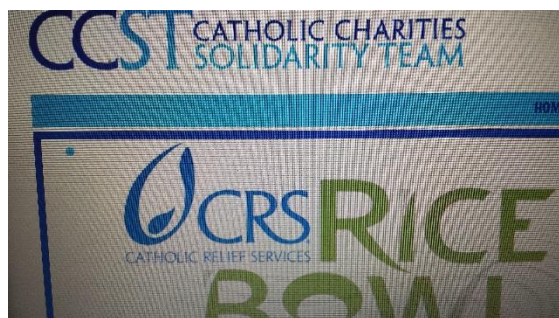

The revamped [ccsolidarity.org](http://ccsolidarity.org) website began its soft launch in July and improvements will continue into August.

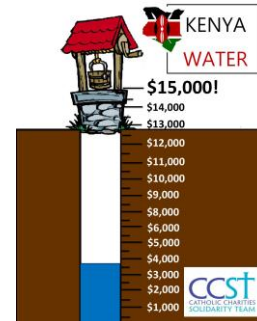
Besides a revised look and feel, the website contains much more information and photos.
